Best Management Practices

Fertility: Recommend 3 to 4 lbs. N/1,000 ft2/year.

Insect Control: All insecticides labeled for use on bermudagrass can be safely applied to TifTuf. Always follow label instructions with insecticides.

Weed Control: All herbicides labeled for use on bermudagrass can be safely applied to TifTuf bermudagrass. Always follow label instructions.
