Designed for beauty and durability, Tifway features dense, fine-bladed growth that spreads quickly, withstands abuse and recovers quickly from wear. It is also relatively resistant to common insect pests.

- ✔ Warm-season variety best suited for Hardiness Zones 7B, 8A and 8B.

Best Management Practices

Sunlight Requirement: Needs full sun (8 hours) for best performance.

Mowing: Height can range from 0.5" to 2.0" but best maintained at 0.75" to 1.5" with a reel mower.

Fertility: Requires 3 to 4 lbs. N/1,000 ft²/year.

Weed Control: All herbicides labeled for use on bermudagrass can be safely applied to SodStar's Tifway 419. Always follow label instructions.

Disease Control: Relatively susceptible to spring dead spot. All fungicides labeled for use on bermudagrass can be safely applied to SodStar's Tifway 419. Always follow label instructions.

Hardiness: Susceptible to winter kill in northern transition zone.

It was released in 1960.
