

Plus, its bright green color creates a striking contrast with darker roughs and putting greens, which is why Zeon was installed on fairways at the prestigious Atlanta Athletic Club, Greensboro Country Club, Carmel Country Club, and Valhalla Golf Club.

On home lawns, Zeon is truly a barefoot grass with softtextured blades that produce less thatch than other zoysiagrasses. And it requires incredibly few inputs and can be maintained with a standard rotary mower, making it very homeowner friendly.

Attributes and Benefits

- Resistant to insects and diseases = reduced pesticides.
- Warm-season variety suited for Hardiness Zones 7B, 8A and 8B

Best Management Practices

Sunlight Requirement: Optimum performance with 4 to 6 hours of sun.

Mowing: Best maintained at 0.250" to 1.0" (reel mower) or 1.0" to 2.0" (rotary mower).

Fertility: Requires less than 2 lbs. N/1,000 ft2/year.

Weed Control: All herbicides labeled for use on zoysiagrass can be safely applied to SodStar's Zeon zoysiagrass. Always follow label instructions.

Disease Control: Zoysiagrass can be susceptible to large patch in spring and fall. Use an appropriate fungicide preventatively on high-end applications, or treat curatively (as needed) on lower-maintenance applications. All fungicides labeled for zoysiagrass can be safely applied to SodStar's Zeon zoysiagrass. Always follow label instructions.

Insect Control: Zoysiagrass is naturally resistant to most insects. Most insecticides labeled for use on zoysiagrass can be safely applied to SodStar's Zeon zoysiagrass
